

Directions to Number Nine

Turn left at the junction as you leave the ferry terminal.

- Keep going straight ahead on the main road (For roughly six miles) till you reach the junction at Northbay.
- As you approach the junction at northbay, You've passing one of the few tree plantations on the Island on the right and in front of you you'll see a bay containing a small islet with a statue of Saint Barr.
- Take the left turn here and Continue north (roughly one mile) till you get to a crossroads with an old red phone box by a white cottage.
- Follow the road which forks right, down to the beach. As shown in the picture above, number nine is the wee stone cottage down on the right as seen in the picture above.

Please note that this map dates from 1926 and predates the road North to the airport and beyond. The Ardmhor road also now extends East to the ferry terminal.
